Whilst these courses are an excellent supplement, they shouldn't be considered a substitute for an industry standard professional qualification.

Essential Pest Awareness



Designed particularly with food production, maintenance, warehousing and retail employees in mind, this entry level course, with a completion time of around 60 minutes, aims to impart the key facts concerning those pests that may present a threat in a food manufacturing or storage environment. Key topics:

- Why controlling pests is important
- How they enter premises
- What they need to survive and multiply
- Rodent and insect pest facts, including Spotting signs of their presence
- The role of the individual in a successful IPM programme

An assessment allows verification that the essential knowledge has been acquired. A certificate is issued automatically when a pass is achieved.





The person responsible for managing pest control should be suitably trained. This course will also appeal to those responsible for auditing pest control activities in their own, or suppliers, sites. The key objectives of this course are:

- To understand the reasons why pest management in a food handling environment is of critical importance
- To review the principal rodent, insect and bird pests
- To examine aspects of their biology and behaviour that are critical to achieving successful control, and which can impact adversely on our ability to control them
- To understand the principles and practices of a successful IPM programme

Pest Control Contract Management



Our Advanced Pest Awareness and Pest Control Contract Management courses may be completed separately. Together, they provide the 'complete package' for anyone charged with managing pest control. - To examine how legislation, and similar constraints, impact on what pest controllers are allowed to do
- To ascertain the objectives of the client and contractor when establishing a pest control contract
- To examine the key elements of a pest control contract specification
- To review the process of selecting a contractor, and managing and monitoring their performance

Bed Bug Awareness




