

Regulatory Alert – Algeria

Delays at ARPCE until further notice

From recent meetings held between PCS and Algerian Regulator – *Autorité de Régulation de la poste et des Communications Electroniques* (ARPCE) – it has been advised that delays can be expected to all Type Approval Applications under review in this country.

In June 2019, ARPCE appointed a new Board Chairman – Mr Zineddine Belattar. During the meetings with ARPCE, it was advised that the power of attorney for the new Chairman is still in process, and that no Type Approval certificates are expected to be signed or released until this process is complete.

It is not currently confirmed for how long this suspension will be in place. PCS are working to clarify further details with ARPCE, including when the Type Approval signatory process is expected to resume.

PCS are continuing to monitor the situation and will keep customers informed once further information is made available.
