

# Regulatory Alert - Mexico

## **Update on new IMEI requirements for Type Approval and import for cellular devices**

Further to PCS' Regulatory Alert issued on 29<sup>th</sup> August 2017 concerning the new IMEI requirements affecting both the Type Approval process and importation of devices into Mexico, the impact to already-Approved WWAN devices has now been established.

It has been confirmed that for all future import consignments of already-Approved WWAN devices, the local holder of the Approval certificate must declare a full list of IMEI's to the Certification Body (NYCE).

If the importer of the device is the local holder of the Approval certificate, the IMEI's for each import consignment can be declared directly to NYCE. If the importer of the device is not the local holder of the Approval certificate, the importer must provide a full list of IMEI's to the holder. The holder must thereafter declare the IMEI's to NYCE.

PCS will remain aware of any developments and will keep customers updated as soon as further information has been released.
