

# Regulatory Update - Indonesia

## **Introduction of Paperwork Only Type Approval Process for Cellular Phones, Handheld Computers, and Computer Tablets through Declaration of Conformity.**

Further to PCS Regulatory Update issued on 14th December 2016 concerning the introduction of a paperwork only Type Approval Process in Indonesia, the Indonesian Ministry of Communication Regulator, has now formally announced that Type Approval can now be obtained for Cellular Phones, Handheld Computers and Computer Tablets through a Declaration of Conformity.

Manufacturers can now apply for Type Approval for this type of equipment by submitting a Declaration of Conformity with test results from the Global Certification Forum (GCF), the Cellular Telephone Industries Association (CTIA) recognised laboratories or from other accredited laboratories that have been approved by the Indonesian regulator, Direktorat Jenderal Sumber Daya dan Perangkat Pos dan Informatika (SDPPI). This new policy is expected to run in parallel with the standard Type Approval process already in place, whereby local testing is conducted. Manufacturers will therefore have the option to proceed via either a paperwork only process, or via local testing.
