

# Regulatory Update

## 802.11ac and 802.11ad Regulations Now Released In Russia

Radio Access Regulations for 802.11ac and 802.11ad standards were released by the Russian Ministry of Telecom and Mass Communications and The Ministry of Justice.

These standards are now included in Order No. 124, and the regulations will officially come into force on 14 June 2015.

Russia Ministry Declarations and Certificates issued before 14 June 2015 for devices containing these technologies will not be affected. Manufacturer can apply to update existing Declarations and Certificates to include 802.11ac and 802.11ad standards on a voluntary basis. Process to update the Declaration and Certificate will be considered as a new application.

Russia Ministry Declarations and Certificates registered at Federal Communications Agency from 14 June 2015, and where applicable, should list the 802.11ac and 802.11ad standards.

PCS can support Type Approval for 802.11ac and 802.11ad in Russia as well as the update of existing Declarations and Certificates to include the 802.11ac and 802.11ad standards.
