

Regulatory Update - Singapore

Singapore Info-communications Development Authority Restructuring - Further Updates

Further to PCS regulatory Alert from March 2016 regarding the restructure of Info-communications Development Authority of Singapore (IDA) and Media Development Authority of Singapore (MDA) into two new Authorities:

- Info-communications Media Development Authority of Singapore (IMDA)
- Government Technology Organisation (GTO).

Further changes have been implemented by the IMDA. The most important changes are as follows:

1. A new website has been created to replace IDA website. The link to the new IMDA website is as follows: www.imda.gov.sg.
2. The Guide for Registration of Telecommunication Equipment has undergone some small administrative changes, however the following text has been included to formalize the previous requirement for identification of equipment:

“The supplier must ensure that the telecommunication equipment is marked with the supplier/manufacturer’s brand or identification mark, and the supplier/manufacturer’s model or type reference. The markings shall be legible, indelible and readily visible”.

3. Labelling requirements have not been updated on IMDA website yet. IMDA have advised that labelling requirements are expected to change and a summary of changes are expected to be published on the IMDA website in October 2016. IMDA also advise that there will be grace period for the transition to new labelling requirements.
