Keep operations running

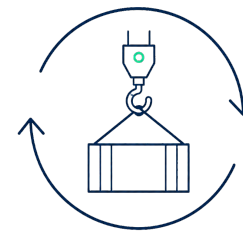
Inspections ensure equipment is ready when needed

Avoid operational disruption

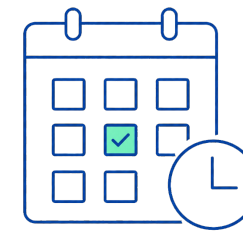
Planned inspections reduce last-minute interruptions
